Cancellation Policy

Peak season (May 11- Sep3): You will receive a refund of your deposit less a cancellation fee of \$75 per room if you cancel 21 days prior to a weekend arrival date. Under 21 days, you will receive a full or partial refund only if we are able to fill the vacancy caused by your cancellation, less a \$100 cancellation fee. If the hotel is unable to fill the vacancy, you will be charged the full amount. There are no refunds or changes on single-night weekend bookings which must be prepaid in full. Peak weeknight cancellations follow same terms and conditions, using 11 days instead of 21 days prior to arrival date.

Off Peak season: 3-day cancellation for weekends; 1-day for weeknights, subject to above terms. There are No Exclusions to this policy.

Room Blocks/Wedding Rooms Cancellation: Use 45 days prior to arrival. Always a min charge of \$50 to cancel or modify will apply.

Children, Rollaways & Pullout Couches

Rooms 204, 205 & 303 have pullout couches.

Rooms 201, 204, 205, 206, 301, 302, 303 & 305 can accept rollaway cots.

Minimum Age for Children is 3 years old. From 3-10 years old, \$25 charge per night. 11 years or older are considered adults at \$50 per night.

ADDITIONAL ADULTS are charged at \$50 per night on a pull-out couch or rollaway cot.

BREAKFAST IS NOT INCLUDED.

ROOM RATES are for Single or Double Occupancy

NEW JERSEY Sales Tax of 7% and Occupancy tax of 5% will be added to your bill.

RULES OF THE HOTEL

SECURITY. Door lock PINCODES are strictly for use of registered occupants only. Use your pincode to access the Main St entrance late at night. Make sure to relock door after entering the building.

OCCUPANCY. If more persons than declared at the time of registration occupy the guest room, hotel may terminate occupancy without any refund. At hotel's discretion, additional occupants may be allowed to stay at a \$50 charge per additional person.

BALCONY USE. Children must be supervised on balconies.

NO COOLERS. An in-room mini-refrigerator is provided.
ICE MACHINE. Available by the 2nd Floor Staircase. In consideration of other guests, please take only what you need. Not intended for parties.

QUIET ZONE, NO PARTIES, NOISE LEVEL. Our facilities are not rented for parties. The Quiet Zone is from 10:30 pm to 10 am, but quiet at all times is appreciated by other guests.

NO PETS. No animals of any kind are allowed at the hotel, unless allowed in writing by the hotel. Violators will be charged a room-cleaning fee of \$300.

SMOKING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED in the Building. Avoid a \$250 fee to restore room or public area to smoke-odor-free state as well as avoid eviction.

BEHAVIOR. Loud and vulgar behavior or drunkenness will result in eviction.

CHECK-OUT time is 11 am. Late checkouts when possible. Otherwise, you will be billed a portion of your room rate if you stay past 11am.

FIRE PREVENTION. Local laws prohibit burning of candles or incense in guest rooms. Candles in rooms are for decoration only. Avoid a restoration fee of up to \$250 for any odor-removal activity.

ROOM DAMAGE. You will be charged replacement, loss of business and repair costs for damage to room furnishings and structure.

ITEMS REMOVED. Articles removed from the room will be charged on your credit card.

BUILDING ACCESS. Past 11 PM, the hotel is accessible only via the front door. Use your pincode to enter.

PARKING is at the rear of the hotel on a first-come, first-served basis. Your vehicle may be towed away if illegally parked in a townhouse slot.
